Five aspects of God's love.

1. Love works as it is \_\_\_\_\_ with patience (vs. 4)
  - It is \_\_\_\_\_ (long-suffering)
  - It is \_\_\_\_\_ (acting kind)
  - It is not \_\_\_\_\_ (to boil with envy or hatred)

The church at Corinth was fighting over who had the "better" gift.

Note: 1 Corinthians 12:27-31 NIV

- It does not \_\_\_\_\_ (to embellish yourself)
- It is not \_\_\_\_\_ (to be puffed up with pride)

Note: Colossians 2:18 NCV

2. Love is \_\_\_\_\_ of other's needs (vs. 5)
  - It is not \_\_\_\_\_ (to not be genuine in your speech)
  - It is not \_\_\_\_\_ (wise in your own concepts or opinions)
  - It cannot be made \_\_\_\_\_ easily (not stirred up easily)

Note: Acts 17:16 NIV

3. Love \_\_\_\_\_ the wrongs it encounters (vss. 5-6)
  - It doesn't remember the wrongs done to it

Note: Romans 12:21 NLT

Instead, it is \_\_\_\_\_ and glad in the reality of the truth.

Note: 2 Corinthians 4:1-6 NIV

4. Love \_\_\_\_\_ hope (vs. 7)
  - It never \_\_\_\_\_ on people (Covers their errors and faults)
  - It never stops \_\_\_\_\_ or believing (to have faith in someone)

Note: Romans 15:13 ERV

- It never \_\_\_\_\_ hope (to trust in the thing that is promised)
- It never quits (to bear up under a burden)

Note: James 1:12 TPT

5. Love will \_\_\_\_\_ come to an end...\_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 8)
  - Love never, not even once, fails
